The work session began at 6:30p.m.

DISCUSSION

Members of the Board of Education, community, and school staff met for the eighth Facilities Advisory Committee (FAC) meeting. Co-chair Bob Mallow called the meeting to order, then asked Superintendent Thompson to lead the committee in reviewing the Shared Commitments and preview the agenda.
