SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

October 18, 2018

CALL TO ORDER

John Stahl called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m., read the Notice of the Meeting, and led those in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Susie Polentini moved to approve the agenda. Aaron Dentz seconded and the motion carried 4-0 on a voice vote.

CITIZENS' FORUM

Valerie Dixon, a community member, asked about whether students have enough time to eat their lunches and noted this was a concern amongst other families too.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS

Superintendent's Report

Dr. Thompson presented the following information:

Teaching and Learning

2019-2020 Student Calendar – The 2019-2020 student calendar was presented as a draft student calendar for next school year. It has been built off of the Arrowhead Area Schools calendar with only a few days that are different between the feeder schools and Arrowhead and includes 178 school days.

Employee Relations

2019-20 Professional Calendar – The 2019-2020 professional calendar was presented as a draft professional calendar for next school year based on the student calendar. There was a discussion on the professional days and possibility of adding an additional floating work day. In the meetings with the staff to prepare both calendars, feedback was considered about features of the calendar that best support the student needs, staff requests and state mandates.

Administrative Position Review Process - Board President John Stahl provided updates on how the process is moving along.

Finance and Operations

Referendum Communications and Community Engagement Planning – Discussion was had on the community informational sessions about the referendum that have already occurred, and what events are still to follow. A preview of what next steps could look like if the referendum passes or fails were also discussed.

2018-19 Budget Updates – Jeremy Struss presented updates for the current year budget now that enrollment numbers have been certified and other data from the state is available in preparation for the passage of the final budget and tax levy later in the month.

Monthly Financial Overview – Jeremy Struss presented the monthly overview for October.

Draft of Five Year Budget Forecast Model – Jeremy Struss presented a draft of projected enrollment and staffing for the next five years to assist the board in future financial planning.

Principal's Report

Mr. Moore presented the following information:

<u>Month in Review</u> – Kyle Moore presented the past month in review with the following topics being discussed: Swallow Education Foundation coffee and parent/principal chat; his recent attendance at the AWSA Elementary Principal's Conference; the school's upcoming lockdown and evacuation drill; and parent/teacher conferences.

<u>Professional Development Activities and Outcomes</u> – Kyle Moore presented the board with updates on staff committees, professional learning during early release days and the upcoming full day for professional development on October 25.

<u>Stipended Extra Service</u> – Andrew Joseph presented and explained the new proposed extra service stipends instead of a flat fee per hours allotted, like it was in the past, for the board's consideration and potential action later in the agenda.

Susie Polentini motioned to approve the Stipended Extra Service Positions as presented. Peggy Moede seconded and the motion passed on a 4-0 vote.

Peggy Moede motioned to approve the 2019-20 Professional Calendar as presented. Aaron Dentz seconded and the motion passed on a 4-0 vote.
