Staff and Parents then surveyed from July 27-31 about Reopening Planning


Parent Participation: 427 responses out of 444 students enrolled (96%)

Staff Participation: 52 responses out of 52 staff members employed (100%)




- I prefer to send my child back to school face-to-face for five days a week this Fall.








If masks or face coverings are NOT required for students, which mode of instruction would you feel is the best fit for your child and/or family?




Thinking about your child, how high of a priority are each of the following to you?




- Yes, my child will ride the bus to and from school on a consistent basis.

As of today, and with the information available from the Staff Reopening Update meetings, which statement best describes your preference for how Swallow reopens in September?






