Meeting Summary and Key Messages for Community July 7, 2020

- Are we open for school? Yes-- the goal is to be back 5 days a week for face to face instruction, with a virtual option as needed. The school start date remains Tuesday, September 8.
- There was discussion about how the school community as a whole can work to lower risks for all to have the safest school experience possible and remain open.
- The health of the staff is the primary focus of the Task Force for initial planning based on demographics and the reality that if there are no staff who can be present to work, there cannot be face to face school.
- Proactive technology planning and professional development is being put into place. A plan for streamlined virtual learning and continuity of learning is being thoughtfully designed.
- We did a lot of brainstorming that we will have further discussion on to drive clarity around plans to meet our goal of 5 days a week of face to face instruction.
- Communication will keep coming via normal school channels including the Thursday Folder, updates at school board meetings, and on the Reopening School section of the website (*Stay Informed* tab).
- Flexibility will be needed by all--what we are planning for on July 7 could change if circumstances change.
