## FEES

## CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENTS/COVID FORM

A signed Conduct Agreement and Covid form <u>must</u> be turned in for each student to be able to participate in graduation activities (enclosed). If the Conduct Agreement/Covid form is not returned signed, the student may not participate in graduation activities.

## **GRADUATION REHEARSAL**

The 8th grade class will participate in an Awards Ceremony in the morning of June 9th. The administration has mentioned that this will be student only attendance. Immediately following the Awards Ceremony, the students will rehearse for the graduation ceremony.

## SEATING FOR GRADUATION

A seating chart will be instituted by Mr. Scanlan and the 8th grade staff, and they will oversee this process. At this time, each graduate's will have 2 seats for their family members. If any guest needs wheelchair accessibility, please have your child share that information with Mr. Scanlan.

## EARLY RELEASE (JUNE 9)

8th grade students will be released from school at around 11:30am on June 9th. No bus service will be available; therefore students will need to arrange their own transportation. Please note, students will need to arrive back at school at 5:30 pm for pictures. It is advised that your child eat a bigger lunch or a snack before they come as there will be no snacks provided this year.

## **GRADUATION PICTURES**

Empire Photography will be taking the pictures of the graduates individually and as a group the night of the ceremony. All students must be at Swallow School, dressed and ready for pictures at 5:30 pm. They will be entering in the choir door entrance. While ordering pictures is optional, it is very important that each student is ready and available. Picture order forms will be forwarded to each student when they become available. ## DAY AFTER PARTY (JUNE 10 FROM 3pm-7pm)

The day after party is a standing tradition for the Swallow graduates. This year we will be having the party at Fox Brook Park at the picnic area #1 (2925 N Barker Rd, Brookfield, WI 53045 **Please note you will need to pay the daily entrance fee or have an annual sticker/pass to enter the park (the entrance fee is required for every vehicle entering the park - even just to drop-off and pick-up).** We are asking parents to connect with each other prior to the event to work out carpooling ahead of time. Food will be served at the party. Please be respectful of the allotted time for the party and pick up your child on time. There will be lifeguards and parent volunteers to chaperone for the event. On the SignUp Genius we will be asking for any parent volunteers that wish to chaperone, help set up, transport food/drinks and clean up. This event is optional. Students should arrive prepared for the beach/picnic (swimsuits, sunscreen, towels, etc...)
