CONTEST DATES: Monday, April 29-Friday, May 10 (Send in Boxtops, Piggly Wiggly, and Sentry receipts to your child's homeroom teacher anytime during those dates!)

COLLECTING: Boxtops, Piggly Wiggly & Sentry Receipts (*NOTE Campbells/Labels for Education have been discontinued by the manufacturer, please DO NOT SUBMIT)

- Boxtops (must have valid expiration intact). To earn DOUBLE POINTS for your class, attach neatly clipped Boxtops in groups of 25 on the collection sheet sent home in Friday folders (also, linked in Swallow weekly e-mail). If you have Bonus Boxtop slips or not enough Boxtops to make a full sheet, please put them loose in a plastic baggie. DO NOT attach Bonus slips to Collection sheets--only the small clipped Boxtops are counted on the collection sheets.
- Receipts, for 1% back to Swallow! Please shop @ **Albrecht Sentry & Fox Bros. Piggly Wiggly** (Hartland or Oconomowoc). *NOTE, Sentry accepts receipts from the past 6 mos only./Piggly Wiggly accepts 2018-19.
