AUDITION PROCESS

• NOW! - Join Band

Step 1: Download Band App or visit site (<https://band.us/>)

Step 2: Search for 2020 Arrowhead Dance Auditions

Step 3: Request to join group and create account. *All members are only visible to coaches!*

- Monday, May 4 & Tuesday, May 5 – **Audition Workshops:** Join live audition workshop to learn routines dancers will need to know for final audition submissions.
- Thursday, May 7—**Submit Final Audition:** Dancers will submit videos to coaches to be judged.
- Saturday, May 9—**Team Announced!** The 2002-2021 Hawkette Dance Team will be announced via Email, social media accounts and website.

VIDEO SUBMISSIONS

You **MUST** follow these requirements when submitting your audition. Dancers should contact coaches prior to Auditions if they have questions or concerns. Videos not submitted correctly may not be accepted

- ⇒ A brief **introduction** stating your name and why you want to join the dance team
- ⇒ Separate **Videos of Pom and Jazz/Lyrical/Contemporary Routines** taught during workshops. Each routine should be performed twice in a row and in a continuous take.
- ⇒ **Skills submission**— All skills must be performed in order and in one continuous take. (Dancers may perform skill twice if they want)
- ⇒ **Other Requirements**
 1. Routines must be performed FULL-OUT.
 2. Videos must be at a high resolution
 3. Videos should be shot at chest level. (Not from side or at an upward angle)
- ⇒ More instructions will be posted in band group.
