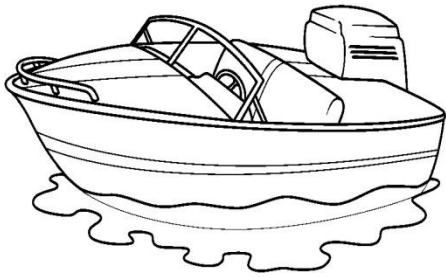


BOATING EDUCATION COURSE
