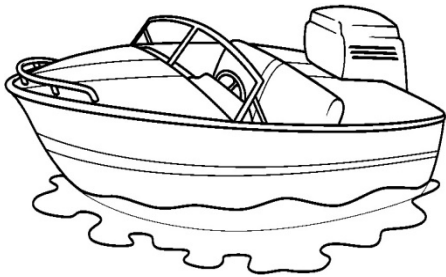


# BOATING EDUCATION COURSE
