## FEE DESCRIPTIONS

## **Fees for All Students:**

### **Book Fees**

Supplies/materials fees for students in 4 year old kindergarten are \$30 per student. Supplies/materials fees for students in kindergarten through eighth grade are \$65.00 per student.

## **Optional Purchases/Fees:**

## 4K-5th Grade Snack

In grades 4K-5 students typically have a snack together each morning (or in the afternoon in the case of afternoon sections of 4K). Those parents who would like the school to provide a snack may purchase these snacks at the beginning of the year for \$53 (or roughly \$0.30/day). This fee will last the entire year and cannot be prorated. Parents who wish to send a snack each day for their child may do so as long as it complies with the district's **Nut-Free Classroom Policy**.

### **TI-108 Calculators**

Students in first through fifth grade use a TI-108 calculator. We will place an order as soon as we find out how many we need at registration, then distribute them to students as soon as they arrive. You do not have to order a new calculator if your child has one from the previous year.

#### **Recorder for Music Class**

Students in third and fourth grade will have the opportunity to play the recorder in music class. Every student must have one. If your child already has a recorder, either passed down from an older sibling or from a previous purchase, you do not have to purchase a new one. For health reasons, we encourage students to not share recorders.

### PLTW Notebook

Students in grades six through eight take a series of three Project Lead the Way engineering courses. Students would benefit from having a design notebook which is aligned to this curriculum to assist with notes for specific projects and laid out for ease of use during the design process. You only need to purchase this item one time, this is for all Grade six and NEW Grades seven and eight students.

### Sketchbook for Art

It is recommended that students in middle school have a Sketchbook to use for class each year. Students would benefit from having this specific Sketchbook as it contains paper that allows experimentation with varied mediums that align with the curriculum and is durable.

## **Hot Lunch**

The Swallow School District offers milk as well as hot lunch options as part of the Food Service Program. The cost of a student lunch is \$3.00 per day and milk will be free to all students (adult lunches will cost \$4.00 per day). There are also a la carte options available. Students can pay with cash or by using their account. **There is a "recurring payment" option.** 

# Athletic Fee (\$75 per sport)

Swallow School is a member of the Arrowhead Middle School Athletic Conference (AMSAC). The conference consists of the following teams: Erin, Holy Hill, Lake Country, Merton, North Lake, North Shore, Richmond, and Stone Bank. Sports offered include Girls and Boys Basketball, Girls and Boys Volleyball, and Track. These fees are assessed once students begin each season.

## Activity Fee (\$25 per activity)

Swallow School provides activities offerings to students and there is a \$25 fee per activity to cover the cost of materials consumed or extra items used to facilitate them. These fees will be assessed once a student joins a school-sponsored activity.

#### Yearbook

Swallow School will now be selling the annual yearbook through its registration fees rather than photo packages or a later yearbook sale through the photographer.
